A BILL

To repeal the renewable fuel program of the Environmental Protection Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Renewable Fuel Stand-
5 ard Elimination Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RENEWABLE FUEL PROGRAM.**

7 Section 211(o) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
8 7545(o)) is repealed.
